Minutes of meeting of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Committee, held on 05-04-2017.

A meeting of the ICT Committee is held today under the chairmanship of Hon'ble District & sessions Judge, Dhemaji at 3.30 pm in the office and chamber of Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge. The following resolutions have been taken in the meeting in reference to the respective items:

Item No 1: Repairing of faulty lease line interface V.35 modem (2 Nos.) at the District Judicial Court Building at Dhemaji.

Resolution No. 1: The Systems Officer stated that the V.35 modem (2 Nos.) has been sent for repair on dated 27/09/2017, 03/01/2017 and 08/02/2017, but the service provider NOMUS failed to repair the same repeatedly. The ICT committee has resolved and directed the systems officer that the said modems are not further required to be sent for repair.

Item No 2: Changing of the Door Signs of Video Conference room at Dhemaji District Judiciary and also cover the window by plywood.

Resolution No. 2: The systems Officer stated the process of changing of the Door Signs of Video Conference room at Dhemaji District Judiciary and also covering the window by plywood is under process.

Item No 3: Regarding purchase of one DVD drive of HP Proliant DL 185G5 Server with serial number SGH012XAHH of E-Courts, Dhemaji.

Resolution No. 3: As one DVD drive of HP Proliant DL 185G5 Server with serial number SGH012XAHH is urgently required, the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge-cum Chairman is requested to take steps to purchase the same from locally as soon as possible.

Item No 4: Regarding undated cases and Judgment uploading in the CIS (Case Information System).

Resolution No. 4: The ICT committee resolved and directed the Systems Officer to provide monthly up to date report regarding undated cases and Judgment uploading in the CIS. The Systems Officer is directed to ensure the updation by various court and also to request the Judicial Officers to monitor periodically the updation report of cases in their respective courts. And the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge-cum Chairman is requested to direct all the Judicial Officers under his jurisdiction to update the cases and uploading judgment in the Case Information System regularly.

Item No 5: Regarding VPNoBB connection at Dhemaji and Jonai.

Resolution No. 5: The Systems Officer has informed the ICT committee that he has communicated the BSNL authority, Dhemaji and Jonai to provide the VPNoBB connection at Dhemaji and Jonai as this connection has to be centrally provided under E-Court Project.

The ICT committee resolved and directed the Systems Officer to pursue the matter so that the VPNoBB connection can be established as soon as possible.

Item No 6: Regarding Broadband connection at District Jail, Dhemaji.

Resolution No. 6: The Systems Officer stated a new BSNL Broadband connection under E-Courts Project is required at District Jail, Dhemaji for Video Conferencing between Jails and Courts. The General Manager BSNL(EB & BP), Assam circle has already been instructed vide letter No. HC.XLV-17(Pt-II)/2008/912/PM&P dated 30/07/2016 to make the connectivity functional at the earliest as per Demand Note dated 12.07.2016 submitted by BSNL to Hon'ble Gauhati High Court.

The ICT committee resolved and directed the Systems Officer to make necessary communication with the BSNL authority, Dhemaji so that the BSNL Broadband connection can be established as soon as possible.

Item No 7: Training to Jail official regarding Video Conferencing System.

Resolution No. 7: The Systems Officer informed that a training programme already be conducted on 21/03/2017 regarding handling of Video Conferencing System between Jail and Courts.
